A mediator is a neutral third party who can help people in conflict find solutions and come to agreement. Mediators learn skills which can be used in personal relationships and professional situations. Participants will learn:

- Different kinds of conflict
- Getting past: "you're wrong...I'm right"
- Effective listening and recognizing non-verbal communication
- Balancing power
- Using neutral language to express different points of view
- Cultural and gender issues in mediation
- Dealing with strong emotions
- Finding "win-win" solutions
- Writing agreements that work
- How to become a volunteer mediator
